Trophy Points System - 2005 Revision

Points are awarded when your cat or kitten attains a 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th in the Open Class of a Championship show, plus additional points for Certificates, Best of Breed and Best in Show/Best of Variety. There are also different points for wins at the Supreme Show each year. The exhibits with the most points in all the different categories (e.g. Seal Point Male Adult, Blue Point Female Neuter etc) are awarded a trophy at the end of the club's Show Season 1 January to 31 December, to be held for one year. The trophies are awarded at the Annual General Meeting. Points are awarded as follows:-

- If a titled exhibit is entered only in the Grand and/or Imperial classes and not the Open, it automatically becomes eligible for Best of Breed and, if successful, receives an extra 6 points.
- At the Supreme Show 6 extra points are awarded for Adult and Neuter Best of Breed.
- Best in Show or Best of Variety winners at Championship shows will be awarded 3 extra points and a further 3 points if judged to be Best Exhibit in Show.
- At the Birman Cat Club Show, an additional 3 points are awarded for ALL Best in Show winners, plus 3 further points for Overall Best Exhibit, i.e. 6 in total.
