Anita's good company and excellent handling of the cats made our day run smoothly and enjoyably.

CLASS 221

SEAL POINT BIRMAN KITTEN FEMALE

1ST & BOB CAWLEY'S CHATMARE BRODIE (13C1) F 10/10/08

A very pretty seal point girl. Strong, broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Cheeks full and round. Level bite. Medium nose with a slight dip in profile. Chin tapers slightly. Almost round eyes of deep blue. Well developed mask, cheeks just a shade lighter at the moment. Excellent bodyweight and correct proportions. Medium, thick set legs with short strong paws. Medium length tail with excellent seal colour developing. Points colour coming in well being darker near to the paws than further up the limbs. Long silken coat of pale beige and a slight seal halo. The left glove is lower and scalloped with just a small amount of white to the inner toe. Right glove scalloped and fuller with slight dip of colour between the two inner toes. Socks even and matching. The gauntlets are matching and taper 2/3 towards point of hock, tapering towards the outside of the legs.

Lovely temperament a pleasure to handle.

2ND NOT AWARDED

3RD NELSON'S ADATELO HANKERKAT SUPASTAR (13C1) F 20/06/08

This young girl was very nervous and upset today. Strong, broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Her eyes are a little two tone at the moment, being lighter on the rim, and appeared a little bold when out of the pen, which could have been because she was so nervous. Medium nose. Strong chin, level bite. Her muzzle was slightly pinched and may improve with maturity if her cheeks fill out. Body and limbs are all in proportion, but was lacking in bodyweight for her age. Medium length full bushy tail, just a little brindled. Mask and points colour well developed and matching. Long, silken coat of pale beige. Left glove is low and scalloped, with a detached white spot next to the stop pad. Right glove is fuller and extends up the outside of the leg but within the standard. Socks even and matching. The gauntlets taper towards a point length, 2/3 to point of hock, the right gauntlet being fractionally longer than the left.

CLASS 222

BLUE POINT BIRMAN KITTEN MALE

1ST & BOB MLYNEK & HAYWARD'S MLYWARD MUNCHKIN (13C2)) M 27/06/08

A well grown boy, with a lot of presence. Strong, broad, rounded skull with medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of excellent deep blue. Medium nose with correct dip to profile, slate grey nose leather. Full round cheeks, & strong chin that tapers slightly and level bite. Full mask of solid blue grey. Long, massive body with medium thick set limbs and short strong paws. Long silken coat and full ruff, clear and glacial, beautifully prepared. Medium length tail, well furnished and solid in

colour matching the other points. Full, pristinely white, matching gloves, both trickle to the stop pad. The left glove had a slight discoloration near to the stop pad. Socks match and are even. The gauntlets are full, extend 2/3 towards the point of hock and have a rounded tip that match on both. This boy shows real promise and has a fabulous temperament, a joy to handle. Well done. Prepared beautifully for the show.

2ND BLATHERWICK'S KYNOBI LUCAS (13C2)

Very friendly boy, with a good bodyweight for his age. Strong, broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of medium blue, with a slightly lighter rim at present. Medium nose with slate grey nose leather. Full cheeks, strong chin that tapers slightly. Mask and ears colour well developed, and at this time quite a lot darker than the limbs and tail colour. Long ,massive body with proportionate limbs, and short strong paws. Medium tail, well furnished. Long, silken coat that is just changing from kitten coat to adult giving a slightly coarse appearance down the spine area. The coat colour is clear and glacial. The left glove is scalloped and slightly irregular. The right glove is also scalloped and trickles right to the stop pad on reverse. Socks are even and match. The gauntlets are even and match, they taper to a neat point 2/3 towards the point of hock. This boy was beautifully prepared and a pleasure to handle.

CLASS 222

BLUE POINT BIRMAN KITTEN FEMALE

1ST HORTON'S KYNOBI TRINITY (13C2) F 08/08/08

A very pretty girl with a lot of promise. Strong, broad ,rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Cheeks full and rounded, strong chin and level bite. Almost round eyes of medium blue, having a slightly lighter rim at present. Medium nose and slate grey nose leather. This girl has a lovely balanced head and exquisite birman expression. Her body & limbs are all in proportion and excellent size for her age. Medium tail with well developed colour, matching her limbs. Long silken coat, ruff developing well. Clear and glacial in colour. Mask and ears fractionally darker than the other points at this time. Low, matching gloves that trickle right to the stop pad on reverse. The right sock is slightly shorter than the left. The gauntlets are even and taper to a point, 2/3 towards the point of hock. Lovely girl a worthy first place.

2ND BAILEY'S NICADAEMUS DREAMONFOXYLADY (13C2) F 29/06/08

Lovely friendly girl who enjoyed being handled. Strong, broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of excellent blue. Medium nose with slate grey nose leather. Cheeks developing, but a little fine in the muzzle at this time. Chin tapers, but not receding. Level bite. Well grown for age with body and limbs all in proportion. Long, silken coat of bluish white, ruff developing nicely. Medium length, bushy tail with good blue grey colour. All points colour developing well, but pale whisker pads at this time. Low matching gloves. The gauntlets match, being narrow and pointed reaching just over halfway towards the point of hock. Socks are low, even and matching.

CLASS 223

CHOCOLATE/LILAC POINT BIRMAN KITTEN FEMALE

1ST & BOB MLYNEK & HAYWARD'S MLYWARD SONIC LARE (13C4) F
27/06/08

WOW what a stunner this girl is, and so mature in her development for her actual age. Strong, broad rounded skull, excellent width between the medium ears. Almost round eyes of deep blue. Slight spectacles around the eyes. Medium nose with correct dip to profile, lilac nose leather. Full, well developed chin that tapers slightly. Level bite. Long, massive body with medium, thick set limbs and short strong paws. Beautifully prepared long, silken coat of clear magnolia, & well developed full ruff. Points colour all matching pinkish grey. Full, bushy, medium length tail. Full, white gloves, even and matching. Left sock ¼ inch longer than the right. The gauntlets match and taper to a point, towards the inner side of legs, length 2/3 towards point of hock. An absolutely delightful girl who enjoyed being handled. Well done.

2ND HOBSON'S TWINKLETOES COSMOS DELIGHT (13C3) F 01/09/08

A pretty chocolate girl with mask developing well for her age. Strong, broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of medium blue. She has spectacles around the eyes at the moment. Cheeks need to develop, & she is a little fine in the muzzle at this time. Her whisker pads are pale, and colour is just starting to develop on her chin. The chin tapers correctly and level bite. Medium nose with chocolate nose leather. Well grown body and proportionate limbs, short strong paws. Medium length tail with slight brindling. Long, silken coat of clear ivory, well prepared. Gloves are full and even, the right trickles right to the stop pad on reverse. Socks match and are even. Her gauntlets are matching in length being 2/3 towards point of hock, the left gauntlet tapers to a point slightly off centre towards the inner leg. Lovely natured girl, a pleasure to handle.

CLASS 224

RED/CREAM/TORTIE GROUP KITTEN MALE

1ST WITHELD

SOUTHERN'S ELLANBEE SUNSET (13C5) MN 03/06/08

A well grown boy with a lovely temperament. Rounded skull that needed a lot more width between the ears. Medium ears with good red points colour. Mask colour developing well, just slight M visible to top of head. Slight spectacles around the eyes. His cheeks need to fill out. Muzzle slightly long and a little pinched. Medium nose with pink nose leather.

Eyes slightly bold, of light blue. Chin tapers slightly and level bite.

Long, massive body with medium limbs and short strong paws. Excellent medium length tail with full brush and well developed red colour, with just a couple of rings visible. Long, silken coat of pale cream, well prepared. Full white gloves that match, unfortunately there is a long white runner up the outside of the right leg that extends a good ½" past the knee joint, making it about 2 " long. The left glove trickles up to the stop pad. Socks match and are even. The right gauntlet is slightly irregular and longer than the left and appears to extend around the outside of the leg at the top.

After judging was finished I learned that the breeder/owners were aware of the withholding faults.

CLASS 224 A

RED/CREAM/TORTIE GROUP FEMALE

1ST & BOB BROWN'S DALTEEMA FANTASIA (13C10) F 03/06/08

A very pretty girl, with excellent bodyweight. Strong, broad, rounded skull with medium ears. The ears have a good even distribution of creams and lilac in a speckled pattern. Full cheeks, strong chin and level bite. Almost round eyes of medium blue. Medium nose with predominantly lilac nose leather and two pink spots on it. Mask developing well with shades of creams and lilac, a lilac stripe down the centre of the mask and nose. Strong chin and level bite. Long massive body with medium limbs and short strong paws. All limbs have points colour of creams and flecks of lilac intermingled. Medium length ,bushy tail, predominantly cream with barely discernable flecks of lilac appearing. Long, silken coat of magnolia ,beautifully prepared. Full matching gloves. Socks match and are even. The gauntlets match and taper very slightly to a rounded end, ½ way to point of hock. A really friendly girl , a pleasure to handle.

A well grown boy with a lovely temperament. Strong broad, rounded skull. Medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of medium blue. Medium nose with slate grey nose leather. Strong chin that tapers slightly, level bite. Long, massive body with medium legs and short strong paws. Long, silken glacial coat with slight blue halo. Solid blue points, all matching. Medium length tail .Gloves slightly irregular/scalloped but match. Matching, even, low socks. The left gauntlet is slightly longer than the right and tapers to more of a point.

1ST NEWMAN'S AMIGAMIA GYPSY ROSE (66 31A)F 17MTH 3 WK

2ND GRIERSON'S POLLYMANDIANT MISTYIE BLUE (13C12) F 11MTH 2WK

A very pretty girl with exquisite birman expression. Strong, broad, rounded skull with medium ears set well apart. Clear M to top of head, slight thumb prints to ears. Medium nose with pinkish nose leather outlined in blue. Almost round eyes of medium blue. Spectacles around the eyes. Speckled whisker pads. Cheeks need to fill out, she is just a little fine in the muzzle at the present time. Chin tapers and level bite. Long, massive body with medium limbs. Tabby barring to legs. Medium tail displaying tabby rings. Long, silken coat of bluish white, well prepared. Gloves are scalloped and low, and trickle to stop pad on reverse. Socks are even. The left gauntlet is full to the point of hock, the right gauntlet tapers to a point 2/3 towards point of hock. Lovely temperament a pleasure o handle.

Almost round eyes of deep blue, spectacles around the eyes. Full cheeks, speckled whisker pads .firm chin that tapers, could be a little stronger for overall balance. Medium nose with pinkish nose leather and blue outline. Long, massive body, medium legs showing even tabby barring. Short strong paws. Gloves match and even, socks match and even. Gauntlets match and taper evenly to a point 2/3 towards point of hock. Medium length bushy tail, showing well defined rings. Long/silken coat of glacial bluish white and bluish halo to shoulder area. Lovely nature, a pleasure to handle.

1ST ATTLEY'S CH & GR PR SYRALLETTE BLUSHING BRIDE (13C1) FN 15YR 3 MTH

This girl is amazing for her age, still all her teeth sound and present!! Her eye colour still sound and coat colour clear and in fantastic condition. Excellent bodyweight, a wonderful example of birman type. built to last!!

Strong broad, rounded skull, medium ears set well apart. Dark seal mask, points & tail all matching. Seal nose leather. Almost round eyes of dark blue. Strong chin, level bite. Exquisite feminine birman expression. Full cheeks. Excellent bodyweight ,body and limbs all in proportion. Short strong paws. Long silken coat of pale beige and a hint of a halo. Full ruff. Beautifully prepared. Gloves are slightly scalloped, the right being slightly lower than the left. Socks even and match. Gauntlets match and taper to a point 2/3 towards point of hock. What a beautiful girl, that so obviously enjoyed her day at the show, well done.

2nd WORMALD'S IMP GR CH DANLEIGH STARBURST (13C6)FN 4YR 10MTH

A very attractive tortie girl, with a wonderful temperament. Strong, broad, rounded skull with medium ears set well apart, a balanced intermingling of varying reds and seal to the ears and full mask. Medium nose with correct dip to profile. Pink and seal nose leather. Almost round eyes of medium blue, with a very slightly lighter rim. Full cheeks, strong chin and level bite. Long massive body, medium limbs, short strong paws. Excellent, balanced intermingling of reds and seal to all limbs and tail. The medium length tail lacked full furnishing at the moment. Full matching pristinely white gloves. Socks match and are even. Gauntlets match and taper evenly to a point, 2/3 towards point of hock. Long, silken coat of clear fawn with a slight halo of reds & seal down the centre of the back.

3rd ALLEN'S PR SPIRITDANCERS DARCEY (66 31)MN 2YRS 6MTH

AV SEMI LONG HAIR CAT/KITTEN OR NEUTER BORN IN JULY

1ST SKELDING'S PR POLARPAWS DRAKOS STAR (13C5) MN 2YR 7MTH

A well grown boy, beautifully prepared.

Strong, broad rounded skull with medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of medium blue, which have a slightly paler blue rim. Full, rounded cheeks, strong muzzle. Strong chin, level bite. Medium length nose with pink nose leather. Long, massive body with medium limbs. All points colour solid deep red. Medium length tail. Long, silken coat of cream, and a golden halo. Gloves matching and slightly scalloped. Socks match, and are even. The left gauntlet is slightly narrower than the right, but are equal in length and taper to a point. Excellent full coat and ruff, beautifully prepared. Excellent temperament.

1ST DELANEY'S DEENLAY MISSDIOR (13C4) F 10MTH 4WK

A well grown girl in beautiful show condition, and very well prepared.

Strong, broad, rounded skull with medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of deep blue. Medium nose with lilac nose leather. Full cheeks, strong chin and level bite. Full mask of pinkish grey. Long, massive body with medium limbs. Medium length tail just slightly brindled. Excellent pinkish grey points colour to limbs. Short strong paws, all pristinely white. Gloves match and are even. Socks match and are even. The left gauntlet is fractionally longer than the right, and slightly blunter than the right. Long, silken coat of clear magnolia, full ruff. Lovely temperament, a pleasure to handle.

2ND BAILEY'S CH NICADAEMUS ROMANY MAGIC (13C2)M 13MTH 1WK

This boy was just a little upset out of his pen today and gave me a clear look at his level bite! Strong, broad rounded skull, medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of medium blue, with a slightly paler rim. Medium nose with slate grey nose leather. Full cheeks, strong chin, level bite. Full bluish-grey mask. Full ruff, long,

silken coat of clear glacial bluish- white. Long, massive body, medium, thick set limbs. Medium/long tail fully furnished and solid blue/grey. Short strong paws. The right glove is slightly more scalloped than the left. The left glove trickles right to the stop pad on reverse. Socks match and are even. The gauntlets taper towards the centre and to a point, both match. Length of gauntlets 2/3 towards point of hock.

3RD DAVIES' GR CH CARRISMOON REDADAIR (13C5) 4YRS 9 MTH

This boy was also let down by his temperament today, being quite difficult to handle out of his pen. Strong ,broad rounded skull with medium ears set well apart. Full red mask. Almost round eyes of medium blue. More preparation was needed especially to the eyes which were quite dirty.

Medium nose with pink nose leather. Full cheeks, level bite. Full ruff. Long, silken coat of pale cream and golden halo. Medium length tail, well furnished of excellent red colour. Long, massive body, medium thick set limbs. Short strong paws. Excellent matching red points colour. Full, even, matching gloves. Matching even socks. Matching tapering gauntlets, reaching 2/3 towards point of hock, finishing in neat matching point

A really big softie. The top of head needs to be broader with more width between the ears. The muzzle also needed to be broader for overall balance. Eyes, medium blue, just a little bold. Strong chin, level bite, with a lower incisor missing. Medium length nose with dark chocolate nose leather. The mask, ears and points colour all very dark chocolate, nearly seal. Long ,massive body, medium, thick set limbs, and short strong paws. Medium length, silken coat beautifully prepared. The coat colour is ivory, with some shading down back and shoulders, but is clear at the roots. Medium length tail with matching dark chocolate colour. Matching, scalloped gloves. Matching even socks. Matching, even gauntlets that taper centrally 2/3 towards point of hock. A lovely temperament, a real pleasure to handle.

Absolutely fabulous girl, wonderfully prepared. Strong, broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of deep blue. Very slight pale spectacles around the eyes. Medium length nose with pink nose leather. Full cheeks, strong chin, and level bite. Exquisite birman expression, lovely well balanced head . Fully developed cream mask, matching ears and points colour. Full ruff. Long ,massive body with medium, thick set limbs. Short strong paws. Medium length tail, well furnished. The right glove is slightly lower and more scalloped than the left. Socks are even and match. The gauntlets are even, match and taper to a point, 2/3 towards point of hock. Lovely gentle temperament, a pleasure to handle.

2ND KAPLAN'S GR CH BAYGAZER KLAWNIQUEKATARINA (13C2) F 2YRS
6MTH

Another lovely girl, I would have liked to have given both these girls a first place in this class. Strong, broad ,rounded skull with medium ears set well apart. Full blue/grey mask and matching ear colour. Almost round eyes of deep blue. Medium length nose, slate grey nose leather. Strong chin, that tapers correctly, excellent bite, lower incisor missing. Full cheeks. Lovely birman expression, very pretty. Excellent bodyweight and all in proportion. Medium, thick set limbs. Short strong paws. Medium length tail, well furnished and with blue grey colour to match the points .The gloves are matching and even. Socks match and even. The left gauntlet is slightly blunter than the right, but match in length 2/3 towards point of hock. Long silken glacial coat, with some shading, clear at the roots. Wonderful temperament.
