Class 150a  
Chocolate or Lilac Birman Kitten male  
No 1<sup>st</sup> awarded

2<sup>nd</sup> SIMPSON'S JANDOUGLAN LORDFLUFFPUSS (13C3) M 02.07.2009

A well grown boy with excellent temperament. Strong, broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of medium blue. medium length nose, with correct dip to profile. Firm chin and level bite. Chocolate mask just covering the nose area at this time. Good bodyweight and all in proportion. Long silken coat of clear ivory, beautifully prepared. Medium limbs with short strong paws. Points colour developing well. Medium length tail, chocolate colour developing well. White gloves that match and slope up towards the outside of leg. The left glove extends a good ½ inch past the stop pad on the reverse, this unfortunately meant I had to withhold the first place award. Socks match and even. Gauntlets match and taper centrally ½ way to point of hock.

CLASS 151B  
CHOCOLATE OR LILAC BIRMAN KITTEN FEMALE.

2<sup>ND</sup> MOTT'S JANDOUGLAN KYLAH (13C4) F 07.07.2009

A very pretty girl. Strong, broad, rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes that are two tone, being rather pale around the rim at present. Medium nose with lilac nose leather. Good firm chin and level bite. Pale pinkish grey points colour just starting to develop on mask and ears. Well grown body all in proportion. Long, silken coat of off white, beautifully prepared. Medium limbs, short strong paws. Gloves are low, even and match. Socks are even and match. Gauntlets match, and taper centrally 2/3 towards point of hock. Excellent temperament. This lovely girl has a medium length tail, which unfortunately has a tail fault/irregularity in the last few vertebrae of the tail near to tip.

3<sup>rd</sup> BURMAN'S ANZARKEE HELENA OF TROY (13C4) F 12.05.2009

Lovely natured girl just a bit light in bodyweight at the moment. Strong, broad rounded skull, medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of pale blue. Medium length nose with lilac nose leather. Level bite. Firm chin, which appears to have a patch of white hairs attached to lower lip. Long silken coat of off-white, beautifully prepared. Points colour just starting to develop. Medium tail. Gloves even but slope towards outside of leg, the left slightly lower than right, there is a small area of white hair just visible above the right stop pad.. Left sock is longer than the right. The left gauntlet is longer than the right almost reaching fully to point of hock. This girl really needs to be heavier at 5 months, perhaps she is a late developer.

CLASS 151A  
RED, CREAM OR TORTIE BIRMAN KITTEN MALE

1<sup>ST</sup> BROWN'S DALTEEMA CHAMPAGNE QUARTZ (13C5) MN 23.02.2009

Lovely boy, excellent size and wonderful temperament. Strong, broad, rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of medium blue, with slightly paler rim at present. Medium length nose, correct dip to profile. Level bite, firm chin that tapers slightly. Cheeks & muzzle need to fill out a little to get a better overall balance to head. Full ruff developing. Well grown for his age, body and limbs all in proportion. Thick set legs and short strong paws. Medium tail, well furnished. Long, silken coat of clear pale cream, groomed to perfection. Mask and points colour developing well to a warm red. Gloves are matching and slightly scalloped. The left sock is fractionally longer than the right. Gauntlets are narrow, pointed and 1/2 way to point of hock.

2<sup>ND</sup> JOHNSON'S DALTEEMA FIREFOX (13C5) MN 23.02.2009

Another well grown boy, with superb temperament. Strong, broad, rounded skull, medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of medium blue, with paler rim making them two tone at the moment. Medium nose with pink nose leather. Cheeks developing well. Level bite. Chin just a fraction weak, sloping away. Full ruff developing well. Excellent bodyweight and bone, all in proportion. Medium, thick set limbs with short strong paws. Medium length tail. Points colour developing well. Long silken coat of pale cream. Beautifully prepared. The gloves are very irregular and low, the inner toes of both front paws barely showing any white at all. Socks, low, even and match. Gauntlets are narrow, taper to a point and are matching.

3<sup>RD</sup> BURMAN'S ANZARKEE LYSANDER DREAMER (13C7) M 31.05.2009

This little boy needs more bodyweight, he is quite small for his age. Broad, rounded skull, medium ears. Medium length nose. Almost round eyes of pale blue, and paler still on rim. He is teething at the moment which may be affecting his eye colour. Chin, cheeks and muzzle all developing well. Mask and points colour developing well, contrast just appearing on the legs. Clear pale off white body coat. Still kitten coat at the moment, well prepared. Medium legs, short strong paws. Tail could be a little longer to balance with body, colour developing. The left glove travels

up the outside of the leg, becoming a runner that passes the stop pad. The right glove is very low and scalloped. The right sock is longer than the left. The gauntlets are not yet clearly defined, but appear to travel all the way up to the point of hock, this may alter as the colour on the points develops. Happy kitten that enjoyed being handled.

#### CLASS 151B

#### RED, CREAM OR TORTIE BIRMAN KITTEN FEMALE

1<sup>ST</sup> BOB GARDINOR'S CARISMOON ATAKAD ASTAR (13C5) F 09.04.2009

A very pretty girl with exquisite birman expression. Beautifully balanced head. Strong, broad, rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of medium blue, slightly paler rim at present. Medium nose with correct dip to profile. Strong chin and level bite. Well. Good bodyweight and all in proportion. Ruff just developing. Medium limbs with short strong paws., medium length tail with colour and brush developing well. Points colour developing well and matching. long, silken coat of pale cream, beautifully prepared. Gloves are matching and even, the white goes right to the stop pad on both. Socks are matching and even. Gauntlets are matching and even, tapering to a point 2/3 of the way to point of hock. Lovely girl, well presented, well done.

Wow what a beautiful boy! And such a sweet nature. Strong, broad, rounded skull, with neat medium ears set well apart. Almost round eyes of very deep blue. Exquisite birman expression. All points colour and mask well developed and matching. Medium nose with lilac nose leather, correct dip to profile. Full chin that tapers slightly. Level bite. Full rounded cheeks.

Long well developed body, excellent weight and bone. Medium limbs and short strong paws.

Tail could be a touch longer for correct balance, but excellent colour and well furnished. Full white gloves that are even and match. Socks match and are even. The gauntlets match, are even and reach 2/3 towards point of hock tapering very neatly to a point. Fabulous boy well done!!

2<sup>ND</sup> MLYNEK & HAYWARD'S CH MLYWARD MUNCHKIN (13C2) M  
27.06.2008

Another excellent birman boy, with definite wow factor! Again fabulous nature and a definite presence. Strong, broad, rounded skull with medium ears set well apart. Excellent blue grey points colour to ears and mask. Almost round eyes of deep blue. Medium nose, slate grey nose leather, strong chin, level bite. Full rounded cheeks. Full ruff. Long, silken coat of glacial white with an overall halo of blue, clear at the roots. Beautifully prepared for show. Well grown body all in proportion, medium limbs, short strong paws. Full white gloves that are even and match. The left sock is

slightly longer than the right. The right gauntlet is slightly blunter than the left, both finish 2/3 way to point of hock. Medium length, well furnished tail. This boy gave the first place exhibit a close run. Well done.

A very handsome boy. Strong, broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart, thumb marks visible on back of ears. Clear M to top of head. Almost round eyes of deep blue. Medium nose, pink nose leather with seal outline. Strong chin, level bite. Full cheeks, speckled whisker pads. Well grown body for age. Medium limbs, short strong paws. Good seal barring to legs. Medium tail well furnished and displaying rings. Long silken coat of pale beige. Coat just needs a little more preparation particularly on the abdomen area. Fabulous temperament. Gloves are even and match, socks are even and match. The gauntlets taper nicely to a point just over halfway towards the point of hock.

Medium length tail, well furnished and well matching colour to points. Long silken glacial coat. Well prepared. Gloves match, the left sock is even and shorter than the right. The left gauntlet is narrow and tapers to a point. The right is wider and blunter but they are of even length and within the standard. Lovely temperament, purred all the time she was being handled.

Firm chin and level bite. Full cheeks.

Long well proportioned body, with medium limbs and short strong paws. Medium length tail fully furnished and a good blue/grey colour to match the points. Long silken coat, beautifully prepared. Glacial white in colour with blue halo, slight halo to abdomen also, but clear at the roots.

Full,white,even gloves. Socks even. The left gauntlet is slightly narrower than the right, both taper and are a matching length.

Lovely boy, who I also gave a first place to in the Birman cat club class.
