SEAL POINT BIRMAN KITTEN

1st & BOB Simmond's GAYEMAUDI CHINA DOLL (13c1) F 12/7/08 Seal Point kitten

A very pretty seal point girl 8months 4 weeks old. Strong, broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong developed muzzle. Level bite Nose medium in length with a slight dip in profile. Nose leather, dark seal brown. Almost round eyes of deep blue. Body long, well-boned and of good substance for age. Medium thick set legs with strong paws. Bushy tail and proportion to the body. Excellent coat soft and silky in texture, Good ruff developing around the neck slightly curled stomach. Super clear pale beige coat with a slightly golden hue compliments all her points being dark brown There was just a slight bit of brindle on her cheeks. The white front gloves are in an even line across the paw and not passing the stopper pad just behind the leg. The back white socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets even taper to a point 2/3 towards the point of the hock Excellent temperament.

BLUE POINT BIRMAN KITTEN

1ST & BOB Izzard's DUBROVA SUMATRA (13c2) M 12/8/08 Blue Point kitten

A well grown boy with a lot of presence. Just 7months 4 weeks. Strong, broad rounded skull with medium ears set well apart. Nose, medium in length with slight dip in profile. Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong developed muzzle Level bite. Nose leather slate-grey, excellent deep blue eyes. Body long, well boned and of good substance, with thick-set limbs, paws short and strong. Bushy tail and proportion to the body. The coat soft and silken in texture, good ruff developing around the neck, slightly curled stomach. The Lovely bluish white cold tone to the coat compliments his blue-grey points. which is beautiful. Matching white gloves in an even line across the paw and not passing the stopper pad just behind the leg. The pristine white socks covering the entire paw, and gauntlets even tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock. Super Temperament and so gentle to handle.

CHOCOLATE OR LILAC POINT BIRMAN MALE.

1ST & BOB Griffith's MUSCAR JENICOL DJEDEFRE (13c4) M 1/8/08 Lilac point

What a strong handsome lilac point boy of good Birman type 8months 1 week old. Strong broad rounded skull, excellent width between his ears. medium nose with correct dip to profile nose leather lilac. impressive blue eyes. Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong developed muzzle, level bite. Long, large, well boned, body of good substance for age. thick-set limbs and short strong paws. Beautifully prepared long soft silky coat, and full ruff around the neck slightly curled on the stomach. Tail bushy and proportion to the body. The off-white magnolia coat compliments his pinkish grey points. Which is outstanding for a boy of this age? The front white gloves even across the paw but trails up the outside of his paws, but not pass the stopper pad behind his legs. The back white socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets tapers toward a point, length 2/3 to point of hock Excellent temperament and loved a cuddle.

CHOCOLATE OR LILAC POINT BIRMAN KITTEN FEMALE.

1st & BOB Griggs CHURSTON VIVA DIVA (13c3) F 7/11/08 Chocolate point.

A sweet chocolate point female just 5months 4days. The skull strong and rounded, nose medium in length with slight dip in profile. Nose leather chocolate. Medium ears set well apart. Cheeks strong, but a bit narrow, but given time she will get better. Just showing a little brindle on her cheeks today. Level bite. Lovely blue eyes body long well boned and of good substance. Medium thick-set limbs and short strong paws Tail bushy, and in proportion to the body. Excellent coat soft and silky to touch medium ruff around the neck, slightly curled stomach. Beautiful ivory coat which compliments her points which is a good milk chocolate in colour. her cheeks are the only place showing a little brindle but will improve with age. The front feet level across the paws. The back socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock. Very gentle lady, and look forward to seeing her when she is older. Excellent temperament.

1st Mott,s ADVILO ERINS SWEETDREAMS (13c3) F 15/7/06 Chocolate point Birman.

A attractive chocolate point female Birman Over 2years 8months of age, Strong broad and rounded skull. With medium ears set well apart. Almost round blue eyes. Cheeks full and round tapering to a developed muzzle. Medium nose with correct dip to profile. nose leather chocolate. level bite. Long body well boned just needed more weight on her today. Legs of medium length and thick-set. Paws short and strong. Tail bushy and proportion to the body. Coat long, silken in texture. Medium ruff developing around the neck, slightly curled stomach. Excellent milk chocolate to all her points which complimented her ivory coat.

White gloves even and matching across the paw the Back socks cover the entire paw and gauntlets tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock. sweet temperament.

A V S/L/H JUNIOR ADULT.

1st Mott's CAMULODUNUM JANDOUGLEN BEN (13C12) M 12/6/08 Blue Tabby Birman.

A very handsome young Birman boy of just over 9months 4 weeks showing good maturity for his age. Strong broad rounded skull with clear 'M' on the forehead Light coloured 'spectacle' markings round his blue eyes Medium ears set well apart, full cheeks spotted whisker pads, firm chin with level bite. Medium nose with slight dip in profile. Nose leather pinkish, with blue outline to tone with colour, Body long, well boned and of good substance for age. medium legs, and thick-set showing even barring. Paws short and strong. Tail bushy in proportion to the body showing some varied clearly defined rings. Coat soft and silky to touch, good ruff around the neck, slightly curled stomach. All points blue on a light beige agouti background off-setting a lovely body bluish white in colour.

Front white symmetrical gloves ending in an even line across the paw and slopes up slightly on the outside of the paw but does not go past the stopper pad just behind the leg. The white socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock. He was very fidgety and obviously more interested in the female cats around him. !!

2nd Simmonds CH MUNKCHIP TOBIAS (13c5) M 16/2/08 Red point Birman.

A well grown Red point Birman just over 1 year 1 month old. With strong, broad rounded skull. Excellent width between his medium red ears. Nose, medium in length with slight dip in profile. Nose leather pink Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong muzzle. Level bite. Eyes blue, a little two tone today! Well grown body with medium thick-set limbs, paws short and strong. Tail bushy and proportion to the body, Coat soft and silken in texture, good ruff around the neck slightly curled stomach. Eyes bright. Beautiful coat, pale cream with slight golden hue. The mask, legs and tail colour is orange/red. With the ears a deep red in colour.

The front white gloves ending in an even line across the paw and not go past the stopper pad just behind the leg. Back white socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets match tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock A pleasure to handle.

3rd Barker's GLOANRON BLOBYU (13c2) M26/5/08 Blue point Birman.

Very friendly blue point Birman. Over 10months old. With Strong broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. nose medium in length with slight dip in profile. Nose leather slate grey. Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong developed muzzle. level bite. Almost round deep blue eyes. Body long well boned and of good substance for age. Medium thick-set limbs, with short strong paws. Tail bushy, and proportion to the body. Coat, soft and silky in texture. Good ruff around the neck, slightly curled stomach. Super bluish white cold tone to the body. Which off-set all his points being blue-grey. White front gloves in an even line but the right glove slopes up the side of the leg not past the dew claw, the left glove almost even across the paw with just a small dip to the paw. The white socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets match tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock. (the right gauntlet just flicks inwards) Very good temperament, and lovely to judge

A V S/L/H LIMIT ADULT.

1st Mott,s JANDOUGLEN SEILEACH (13c13) F 14/3/06 Chocolate Tabby Birman

A very pretty female, of good Birman type. Skull, strong, broad and rounded. With medium set ears spaced well apart. Nose, medium in length with slight dip in profile. Clearly defined 'M' on the forehead deep blue eyes light coloured spectacle markings round the eyes. Nose leather pinkish to tone with the points. Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong developed muzzle. Level Bite. Excellent body weight and correct proportions. Medium thick set legs with short strong paws. Tabby barring on the legs. Tail bushy, and proportion to the body, showing some varied size rings with a solid tip to tail. Excellent coat condition, good ruff around the neck, slightly curled stomach all points clearly defined milk chocolate markings on a light bronze agouti background to compliment her ivory coloured body The front gloves matching to an even line across the paw with the right front paw has a slight flick going up the outside of the paw, but does not go pass the dew claw. The back white socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets match nicely tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below to point of the hock. My comments have not altered about this female Birman

as I judged her exactly 2weeks ago. Her temperament is excellent and she just has a special personality to please when being judged.

Avery attractive Chocolate Tortie of good Birman type. Over 10months 2 weeks. Skull strong broad and rounded with medium ears set well apart. Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong developed muzzle. Level bit. Medium nose with a slight dip in profile. Nose leather left side was pink and the right side was intermingled. Very expressive blue eyes. Long, well- boned body and of good substance. Medium thick-set legs with paws short and strong. Tail bushy and proportion to the body, Coat long, silken in texture with good ruff round the neck, slightly curled stomach. Body ivory shading unevenly to pale chocolate, with very pale red on back and sides developing. All points milk chocolate intermingled with shades of light and dark red. The white front gloves are low ending in an even line across the paw. the back white socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock. Excellent Temperament .

2nd Mason's AMILLIANA MIZZ ATTITUDE (13c1) F 17/6/07 Seal point Birman.

A pretty seal point Birman almost 1year 10months strong, broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Cheeks full and round. Level bite. Medium nose with slight dip in profile. Chin tapers slightly. Almost round eyes of deep blue Well developed mask Excellent body weight and correct proportions. Medium thick-set legs with short strong paws. Bushy tail in proportion to the body. Coat long, silken in texture full ruff around the neck slightly curled stomach. Boyd clear pale beige with a slightly golden hue compliments her excellent points dark brown. Front white gloves a bit generous, in an even line across the paw but does not go pass the stopper pad just behind the leg. The back white socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets tapering up the back of the leg to finish just behind the point of the hock. Excellent Temperament.

A super seal point female of excellent Birman type. Strong, broad rounded skull, with medium ears set well apart. Nose medium in length with slight dip in profile. Nose leather dark seal brown. Excellent deep blue eyes. Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong developed muzzle. Level bite. Excellent body weight and correct proportions. Medium thick-set legs with short strong paws. Bushy tail and proportion to the body. Excellent coat condition silken in texture full ruff around the neck, slightly curled

stomach. All points are dark brown complimenting her body, clear pale beige with a slightly golden hue. Pristine white front gloves. The right glove is slightly higher than the left front glove both even across the paw and not passing the stopper pad just behind the leg. Back white socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock. We had another cuddle Super temperament.

3rd Brigliadori & Dr Robson's GR CH SHWECHINTHE MANGOKUFI (13c10) F 10/5/05

Lilac Tortie point.

Another beautiful female of excellent Birman type. Skull strong, broad and rounded. Ears medium in size and spaced well apart. Nose medium in length with slight dip in profile. Nose leather pinkish/faded lilac. Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong developed muzzle. Level bite. Expressive blue eyes almost round but not bold. Well grown and well proportioned female, good body length and weight with medium thick set legs with short strong paws. Tail bushy and in proportion to the body. Coat soft and silky in texture. Good ruff around her neck slightly curled stomach. Her points colouring is lilac intermingled with light cream. Which compliments her body magnolia shading unevenly to pale lilac and pale cream on back and sides. Front gloves white in an even line across the paw. the back white socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock. Excellent temperament, and a pleasure to judge.

A superb Chocolate Tabby female of Excellent Birman type. Over 10years of age whom I recognised from judging her, just two weeks ago. And in that time she looks as Beautiful as ever .Stunning blue eyes with spectacle markings round the eyes with spotted whisker pads

Pinkish nose leather to tone with the points.. Excellent grooming to her ivory coat, with points milk chocolate on a light bronze agouti background. Rounded cheeks

tapering to a strong developed muzzle. Level bite. Clearly defined 'M' marking on the forehead ears medium set well apart. Medium thick-set limbs with paws short and strong. Body long well boned with substantial weight. Bushy tail in proportion to the body with rings to the underside of the tail. Tabby barring to legs. Matching gloves and even socks Gauntlets even tapering up the back of leg to finish just below the point of the hock. Strong body well boned with substantial weight
Excellent temperament, so gentle to handle Look forward to the next time

2nd Lee's CH & SUP UK GR KALEMYO KLAWSFOR APPLAUSE. (13c11) FN 17/5/2000. Seal tabby point Birman.

Another stunning female of excellent Birman type just under 9 years of age. Strong, broad, rounded skull with medium ears set well apart Clear 'M' to top of head, light coloured spectacle markings round the eyes with spotted whisker pads almost round blue eyes, not bold. Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong developed muzzle. level bite. Body long well boned and excellent weight, with medium thick-set limbs, paws short and strong. Tabby barring to legs. Medium tail displaying tabby rings. Medium length coat groomed to perfection Full matching gloves. Socks match and are even. Gauntlets tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock. All points seal brown on a pale a pale brown agouti background, showing off his clear pale beige body with a slight golden hue. Lovely temperament, and a pleasure to handle.

3rdBell's GR PR ARCASDY MOPSA (13c13) FN 1/5/2000 Chocolate tabby point Birman

Another lovely mature female almost 9 years of age. fabulous condition and very good Birman type. Strong, broad and rounded head. 'M' marking on the forehead, light coloured spectacle markings around her deep blue eyes, almost round and not bold. With spotted whisker pads. Medium ears spaced well apart, with faint thumbprints. Long medium body with legs medium length and thick-set paws short and strong Tabby barring to legs. Bushy tail in proportion to the body displaying tabby rings. Coat, soft and silky in texture. Full ruff round the neck, slightly curled stomach all points milk chocolate markings on a light bronze agouti background complimenting her ivory body. The front gloves white even across the paw but low, Even socks, Good gauntlets left is medium, long, full and nicely tapered. . Right is slightly lower but also full in shape A very gentle Birman to judge.

2nd Wood's PR RIVANNA FIORELLA (13c11) FN 11/12/07 Seal tabby Birman. Lovely well grown seal tabby point female of good Birman type. Strong broad head, rounded skull with medium ears set well apart with clear thumb prints. 'M' marking on the forehead, light coloured spectacle markings round her deep blue eyes. spotted whisker pads. Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong developed muzzle. level bite Nose medium in length with slight dip in profile. Pinkish nose leather to tone with points.. Body long, well boned and substantial weight. Limbs medium length and thick-set, paws short and strong. Tabby barring to legs Proportioned bushy tail

displaying tabby rings. All points seal brown on a pale agouti background which complimented her beautifully groomed coat of clear pale beige with a slight golden hue. Pure white matching gloves and even. the back socks covering the entire paw and gauntlets tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock. Excellent temperament. and very laid back.

1st Groves GR PR SPELLAINGER MOON BALLAD (13c2) MN 3/5/02 Blue point
A lovely mature male almost 7 years of age with excellent Birman type. Strong skull with a lovely broad head, Cheeks full and round tapering to a strong developed muzzle. Nose medium in length with slight dip in profile. Nose leather slate-grey. level bite. Medium ears set well apart. Very impressive eyes almost round but not bold. Body long, well boned, and of good substance. Thick-set limbs Paws short and strong. Tail bushy and proportion to the body. Coat long silken in texture, full ruff around the neck slightly curled on stomach. the mask, ears, legs and tail blue-grey and clearly defined. Pure white socks even across the paw and not passing the stopper pad just behind the leg. Even white socks, gauntlets tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock Lovely temperament and super to handle.

2nd Price's SUCETTE NOTTHE LASTROLO (13c3) FN 28/5/05 Chocolate point
A very pretty chocolate point female just over 3years 10months of very good Birman type
Strong broad rounded skull, Nose medium in length with slight dip in profile. Nose leather chocolate, Cheeks full and round tapering to a well developed muzzle. Deep blue eyes almost round but not bold. Medium, thick-set limbs, with paws short and strong. Body long, well boned and of excellent substance. Tail bushy and proportion to the body The coat long, soft and silky with beautiful clear ivory coat. Full ruff around the neck, slightly curled stomach. All points milk chocolate showing no brindle. Gloves are full and even across the paw. and Socks white covering the entire paw and gauntlets tapering up the back of the leg to finish just below the point of the hock. Lovely to handle, just a little chatty because we disturbed her resting time.!!
