CONDITIONS FOR JOINING THE CLUB

- Members are reminded that annual subscriptions are due on the 1st January each year and should be sent to the Membership Secretary at the above address. Should subs not have been paid by the end of March, membership will be deemed to have lapsed.
NB Members joining after the 1st October get 15 months initial membership before they need to renew.
- Members are strongly recommended not to sell kittens under the age of 13 weeks, and at least 7 days after completion of a full course of vaccination, except in exceptional circumstances.
- Members undertake not to sell kittens for show or breeding, when it is obvious at the time of sale that the kitten is strictly pet quality.
- Members are recommended to keep records of their kittens with regard to any illness requiring Veterinary treatment.
- Members are recommended to make these records available to purchasers at the time the kitten is sold.
- It is recommended that, if a cat is bought for breeding and has to be taken to a cat at public stud, the premises should be inspected before leaving the queen.
