

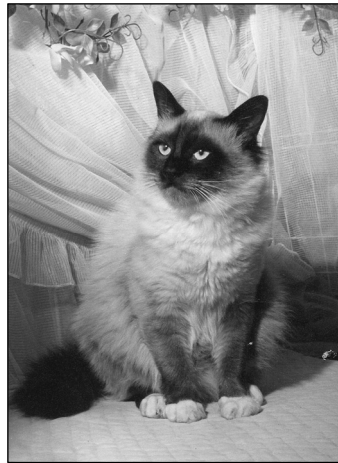
Front cover photograph:
